

**EMUHSD Draft By-Trustee Area Maps – Descriptions
January 26, 2022**

From the following three drafts: **NDC Orange Map**, **NDC Yellow 2 Map** and **NDC Green 3 Map**, the Board of Trustees will consider and adopt a final map during a public hearing at its next meeting on **Feb., 2.**

New/Revised Maps:

NDC Green 3 – Posted January 26, 2022

- Requested by Board at January 5th Board Meeting
- Small revision to ensure the area bordered by Santa Anita Ave on the west, Bryant Rd on the north, Tyler Ave on the east, and Valley Blvd on the south is united in proposed Trustee Area 3, as per Board direction
- Remains within the allowable population balanced range with this change, so no offsetting change was necessary
- Each attendance area has at least two Trustees and all Trustees except Area 1 have portions of at least two attendance areas.
- There are three majority-Latino Trustee Areas and one majority-Asian Trustee Area by Citizen-Voting Age population (CVAP)

NDC Yellow 2 – Posted December 20, 2021

- Requested by Board at December 8th Board Meeting
- Moves a small part of Area 2 into Area 3 along the railroad west of Tyler Ave, as per Board direction
- Two more compact areas in the north
- Divides both Rosemead and Temple City
- Each attendance area has at least two Trustees and all Trustees except Area 1 have portions of at least two attendance areas.
- There are three majority-Latino Trustee Areas and one majority-Asian Trustee Area by Citizen-Voting Age population (CVAP)

NDC Green 2 – Posted December 1, 2021

(Consensus from the Board to drop Green 2 map from further consideration)

- Requested by Board at November 3rd Board Meeting
- Moves Area 3 to Tyler Ave, adjusts Areas 1 and 2 to compensate
- Two trustee areas south of I-10 with an east/west division
- Two more compact areas in the north
- All Trustees have portions of at least two high school attendance areas and each attendance area has at least two Trustees
- There are three majority-Latino Trustee Areas and one majority-Asian Trustee Area by Citizen-Voting Age population (CVAP)

New/Revised Maps (Continued):

NDC Orange – Posted October 18, 2021

- Follows major roads and Rio Hondo
- Keeps Rosemead in a compact area
- Each attendance area has at least two Trustees and all Trustees except Area 1 have portions of at least two attendance areas.
- There are three majority-Latino Trustee Areas and one majority-Asian Trustee Area by Citizen-Voting Age population (CVAP)

NDC Purple 2 – Posted October 18, 2021

(Consensus from the Board to drop Purple 2 map from further consideration)

- Creates a substantial division of Rosemead
- Creates four trustee areas along the north, south, west, and east sides of the district and one trustee area in the center
- Use of Rio Hondo as a major division
- All Trustees have portions of at least two high school attendance areas and each attendance area has at least two Trustees
- There are three majority-Latino Trustee Areas and two majority-Asian Trustee Areas by Citizen-Voting Age population (CVAP)
