

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
EI MONTE UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT  
DRAFT MAPS FOR BY-TRUSTEE AREA ELECTION SYSTEM**

The El Monte Union High School District (“District”) is in the process of moving from an at-large election system, where members of the District’s Board of Trustees (“Board”) are elected by voters of the entire District, to a by-trustee area elections system, where each Board member must reside within the designed trustee area boundary and is elected only by voters in that trustee area. Before adopting a map of the boundaries for the trustee areas, Elections Code section 10010(a)(2) requires the District to hold at least two public hearings at which the public is invited to provide input regarding the content of the draft map or maps and the proposed sequence of elections, if applicable.

On October 6, 2021, the District held the first of the two statutorily required public hearings to receive community input on the draft trustee area maps prepared by National Demographics Corporation (“NDC”). On November 3, 2021, the second statutorily required public hearing was held to receive community input on the draft trustee area maps. The District also held two additional public hearings on December 8, 2021, and January 5, 2022, to provide further opportunities for the community to give input to the Board on the draft trustee area maps.

After receiving comments during the January 5, 2021, public hearing, as well as feedback taken during several community open houses and previous public hearings, the Board reached a consensus to eliminate the NDC Yellow, NDC Green and NDC Green 2 maps and requested changes to the NDC Green map to create a new NDC Green 3 Map.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on February 2, 2022, as part of its process of transitioning to a by-trustee area elections system, the El Monte Union High School District Board of Trustees, will hold a final public hearing to receive community input regarding the proposed trustee area maps, the proposed sequence of elections, and the transition to trustee area elections. The Board will then consider and select a final trustee area map to be adopted and submitted to the Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization for its consideration.

The Board of Trustees will consider the following three draft maps for final adoption: [NDC Orange Map](#), [NDC Yellow 2 Map](#), and a new NDC Green 3, which is being developed by NDC and which will be made available to the public at least seven days prior to the public hearing.
