[El Monte Union High School District](#) on Wednesday, Jan. 5, will hold its sixth public hearing to narrow down the number of maps under consideration for the transition to by-trustee area elections, which for the district will begin in the November election.

The Board of Education meeting will begin at 6 p.m. and the public is invited to participate virtually or in-person (at 3537 Johnson Ave., El Monte) and offer input on the proposed maps, of which there are seven, developed by National Demographics Corporation.

The Board of Trustees will select a final map on Feb. 2 at the final public hearing on the matter. The map will then be presented to the Los Angeles County Committee on [School District](#) Organization for approval.
